SRI makes every effort to minimize the exposure to such materials and is committed to protecting our workforce and environment from hazardous materials and chemicals by:

- Identification of hazardous materials, and chemicals that may be found in the office environment such as light bulbs, cleaning supplies, toner, and batteries
- Educate staff and others that may come in contact with hazardous materials, regarding the proper handling and disposal
- Replace potential hazardous materials with nontoxic substitutes, when possible
- Provide recycling services for the proper disposal of electronics, and household supplies
- Follow government regulations pertaining to use and disposal of hazardous materials and chemicals
- When visiting a client site, abide by customer on-site hazard material and chemical policies and procedures, including the use of protective gear
