



Community Volunteer Policy

Effective January 1, 2017

Bassetti Architects is committed to demonstrating the nature and extent of our community volunteer involvement. Community volunteering by an organization is an investment in its community and its people. Volunteering provides valuable community services and strengthens a community in many ways such as supporting families, improving schools, supporting youth, and beautifying the community. Community volunteering is an important measure of the civic health of a community, a state, and a nation.

Bassetti Architects sets aside a minimum of 10% of each employee's annual paid time for non-billable activities including continuing education and community involvement, with larger allotments budgeted on an individual basis. We expect and encourage employees to use at least 16 hours of this paid time for volunteering with community and professional organizations.

Each year, Bassetti Architects will organize one or more coordinated volunteer activities for the entire firm.
